





The Suburban Reach is a very active recreation zone between 119th Street and County Line Rd. Activities include all trail uses except equestrian. Small parks adjacent to the trail allow for picnicking, watercraft take out and other park uses. Adjacent land uses need to front onto the Greenway and use the trail system as an amenity. Social trails should be discouraged.




Greenway Corridor

Greenway Corridor






The width of the Corridor needs to be adequate to protect the resource, as well as respond to activity areas and resource constraints along the Greenway. In general, this Corridor width should be narrow enough to encourage adjacent uses every opportunity to use the trails as an amenity. Grades rise rapidly north of the Burlington Northern Railraod R.O.W. thus provide a natural separation and edge to to the Greenway Corridor.
